

# **HEALTH & SAFETY INFORMATION**

Important Inf

- For your safety, please respect and listen to Cascades staff operating games and activities.
- No fires, fireworks, firearms, open flames, or alcohol.
- **Bikes:** Please stay on roads and off trails. Don't forget your helmet! Park bikes in designated areas.
- Speed Limit: 15mph or slower bicyclists, walkers, and kids are around!
- **Pets:** Pets must be kept on a leash, quiet, and may not enter any buildings. Please clean up after your furry friends!
- Hiking: Hiking to Fossil Rock is restricted, but enjoy our other trails!
- Swimming: Swim only when lifeguards are on-duty (see page 2).
- **Boats:** Children under 13 yrs must be accompanied by an adult. All boaters must wear life jackets.
- Quiet Hours: 10pm-7am
- Emergencies: Please call 911 and alert Cascades staff by calling the program host phone (360) 375-5709. If you need assistance in the evening or after dark, head up to Deer Ridge Lodge and follow instructions provided. AEDs are located in the Nisqually Center kitchen and Deer Ridge Lodge.

## **DINING INFORMATION**

- Wristbands: Meal plan participants will be asked to show wristbands for entry to the dining room for all meals: <u>Green</u> - all meals | <u>Yellow</u> - dinners only | <u>Red</u> - BBQs only

- Sunset Park Adventure Course: Thurs-Sat 2:30pm; Fri 4pm | Must be 5ft or taller and between 45-250lbs. Close-toed shoes required. Do not climb on the adventure course when it is not staffed.
- **Paintball:** Thurs & Sat: 4pm | \$10 | Meet at the Ball Field | Must be 13+ yrs to play | Sign-ups required
- Climbing Tower: Thurs-Sat: 4pm | Climbers must fit harness (roughly 5+ yrs) | Sign-ups required
- Waterslide: Thurs-Sat: 1-5pm | No sign-up required | Must be 4ft to slide
- Zip Line: Thurs-Sat: 1pm | Must weigh between 80-250lbs. for individual and tandem riders | Tandem available for children 5+ yrs. under 80 lbs (must ride with parent/guardian over 18 yrs) | Sign-ups required
- **Pony Rides:** Thurs-Sat: 10:30am | Under 10yrs | Meet at Sunrise Ranch | No sign-ups necessary
- **Pinecars:** \$20 each at the Canteen | Construction on the East Lawn Thurs & Fri 10:30am-12pm & 1-5pm | Show & race will be at 10:30am on Saturday outside Rainier Center | Note: All pinecars must be purchased & made at Cascades this year in order to compete
